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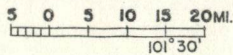
AN EXAMPLE OF  
STATE BOUNDARY CONTROL

THESE ARCS OF FIRST-ORDER TRIANGULATION WERE ESTABLISHED STRADDLING THE OKLAHOMA—TEXAS BOUNDARY, AT THE REQUEST OF THE TWO STATES. SUPPLEMENTAL STATIONS WERE ESTABLISHED FROM WHICH THE BOUNDARY LINE WAS TO BE MONUMENTED.
