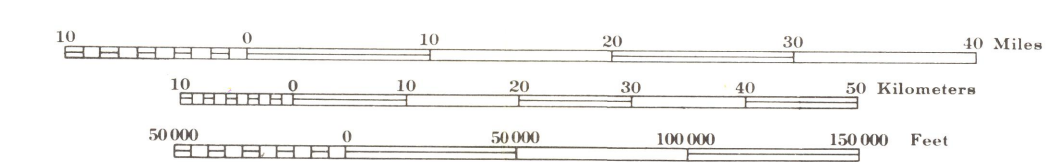
Key to numbered stations will be found in a separate list.
